Frequently Asked Questions about Cub Family Day

Focus of this event: This event is themed for fall fun and fellowship. We have invited Community Organizations, such as the Army Reserves, Fire and Police Departments, etc. It is a fun event for everyone in the Cub's family.

Why is the fee \$10.00 per person? This fee is an entry fee, not a participation fee. Everyone who attends the event pays the fee. At this event there is something for everyone and is geared to our Cub Scout families. Cubs will have their own activities, younger siblings will have some activities, and adults will be able to visit all the organizations that are present to gain knowledge and resources to help with service projects and additional opportunities that they can participate in as packs and/or families. There is a patch included in the fee.

Is this a Day or Camping event? This is a day only event, however families can register for the CubCamporee instead if they want to camp. Check-In is from 10am-11:30am. You will be expected to leave when the activities conclude at 4pm.

Is food being served at this event? There is no food included in the fee, however vendors will be present to sell all kinds of food for lunch and our trading post will also be open to sell snacks, drinks, and other merchandise. We have worked hard to keep the prices for food affordable. Hot dog, chips, and a lemonade will run about \$6.00. The Kona Ice truck will also be there. You are welcome to pack in a lunch or buy from our vendors.

Is transportation to activities available? As with all events at Camp Sidney Dew, there is a no driving policy enforced. There is no transportation provided, however, this event will not be on a schedule other than the opening. So you can take your time to meander around camp to all the activities you want to see. We will space them as close as we can, but there will be some hiking involved. If you cannot walk uneven terrains or have the stamina for a long hike, this event may not be the one for you. Please encourage those attending to stay hydrated and take the time to enjoy Camp Sidney Dew.
