Youth Protection training - All volunteers must complete this training to apply. It is available online on the Web site www.myscouting.org. As a volunteer, you are expected to complete the training every 2 years.

**Activity Standards:** Where swimming or boating is included in the program, Safe Swim Defense and/or Safety Afloat standards are to be followed. If climbing/rappelling is included, then Climb on Safely (which recommends the American Red Cross' standard first aid and When Help is Delayed or equivalent course) must be followed. One adult in the group must be trained for each activity. At least one person must be trained in CPR from any recognized agency for Safety Afloat and Climb on Safely. Planning and Preparing for Hazardous Weather trained adult is required for a tour permit. Consult the Guide to Safe Scouting and Age Guidelines for Scouting Activities for more information.

- \* Safe Swim (mandatory for activities in or on any kind of water, the number of adults depends on the activity. It is covered in the training. Training must be repeated every 2 years) Swimming and Water Rescue is recommended to suppliment Safe Swim
- \*\* Safety Afloat (mandatory for an activity on any kind of water, the number of adults depends on activity. It is covered in the training. Training must be repeated every 2 years) At least one person must be trained in CPR from any recognized agency for Safety Afloat. Paddle Craft Safety is recommended to suppliment Safety Afloat.
- \*\*\* BALOO Training (This training is required for any adult who is in charge of planning a pack hike or campout)
- ++ Currently if a volunteer is registered in multiple unit types (e.g., Venture Crew and Boy Scout Troop), they only need to take the general Youth Protection Training
- +++ At least one person must be trained in CPR from any recognized agency for Safety Afloat and Climb On Safely
