Cub Spook-O-Ree Information

Registration:

Registration is on nwgabsa.org. There are two options to register your unit:

- 1- Log on to your Tentaroo account and register under events. Clicking the red button on the event webpage will go to the Tentaroo log in screen. This option is sometimes preferred by larger packs.
- 2- Go to the event webpage and fill out the form at the bottom of the webpage. This option is sometime preferred by smaller groups. This option has a maximum input of 16 youth and 8 adults.

Check-In:

Check-in will take place on Friday evening and Saturday morning at Simmons Shelter, next to Hubbs. Unit gear haul and trailer escort will only be available on Friday evening.

For Packs who will be camping the entire weekend, check-in will be Friday evening between 6:30 pm and 8:30 pm. Those who are day-only participants may check-in on Saturday morning from 8:00 am to 9:00 am.

Cars & Parking:

No vehicles other than those designated by the Camp Ranger will be allowed to drive on camp. Vehicles towing unit trailers will be escorted to and from campsites and may remain at the campsite, hooked to the trailer, during the event. All other vehicles must always remain in the parking area.

Fees & Patches:

The registration fee for each youth attending (ages 3 and up) is \$18 and adults and leader fee is \$5.00. The youth registration fee includes a patch and all activities on Saturday. Parents or youth who wish to purchase (additional) patches may do so for \$5 per patch at registration while supplies last.

Registration closes October 9th at midnight.

NOTE: All registration fees need to be paid online or within 10 days of registration by mail or at the NWGA Scout Service Center.

Late Registration Fees:

Any registration submitted after midnight on October 9th will be charged an addition \$5.00 per person. Youth fees increase to \$23.00 and Adult/leader fees increase to \$10.00 till October 16th.

Refunds:

It is the policy of the Northwest Georgia Council, that all fees are transferable but not refundable. However, refunds may be requested in writing, two weeks prior to the start of the event for unforeseen circumstances. Failure to participate in an activity does not warrant a refund.

Unit Camping Reservations:

Unit camping will be allowed for 2 nights on October 21st and 22nd. Units may choose to camp only Friday night, only Saturday night, or both nights. Units will need to choose their camping nights during the event registration process. Campsites will be assigned by event staff based on unit size and any medical needs. Units will be responsible for their own gear haul either in a unit trailer or consolidated into 1 or 2 vehicles.

Program Times & Activities:

Cub Spook-O-Ree Program will begin at 9:30 am and will run until 5:00 pm. For units camping there will be additional activities after supper.

Participants will be grouped into small groups for the day. Everyone will have an opportunity to explore all the activities along with their group. Groups will be assigned at check-in. We will make every attempt to have all members of a given Pack in the same group. Each group will be assigned time slots in which they will travel to and participate in various activities.

Events will be held on the Lake Goodyear side of the camp, near Blackfoot Shelter. All programs will be centrally located in this area to help minimize travel between program stations.

The official schedule for the day's activities for your assigned group will be given to your unit at check-in.

Meals:

Units are responsible for cooking their own meals for the weekend. Waguli Lodge will have presale lunches available for \$6, meals consisting of a hamburger or hot dog. Price of meal purchased at the event price will increase to \$7. The mobile trading post will have beverages and small snacks available to purchase. Adequate trash cans and recycle bins will be placed strategically throughout the camp. Remember a Scout is clean.

First Aid:

There will be a health officer at camp for any first aid needs during the event. Please make sure that your units have complete and updated BSA health form (parts A & B) for each person attending. These forms will remain with the Pack Leader or individual families. BSA Health forms can be found on the BSA National website at: <http://www.scouting.org/scoutsource/HealthandSafety/ahmr.aspx>. First-aid assistance is available by contacting a member of the event staff or through radio communication accessed at Hubbs Reception, Saul Dining Hall, or note base station locations on any map around camp.

Trading Post:

A mobile trading post will be open during the day in the program area, snacks and drinks will be available for purchase. Be sure to grab some Sidney Dew gear before leaving camp!

Alcohol and Tobacco:

There is "zero tolerance" with the regard to the possession and use of illegal drugs and/or alcohol in camp at any time. Anyone found to be in violation of this National Boy Scouts of America Policy will be expelled from camp property. Please inform your parents accordingly.

It is the policy of the Boy Scouts of America that the use of tobacco products, including e-cigarettes/vaporizers, must be done out of the view and smell of any youth.

Vehicles:

Vehicles must be parked in the parking lot only. No vehicles will be permitted to drive in and around camp program areas at any time during the event.

Handicap Transportation:

If you have a medical condition and need assistance to get to the program area, please let the staff know at registration during check-in.

Personal Carts and ATVs:

The use of personal golf carts, ORV/UTV/ATV's will not be permitted.

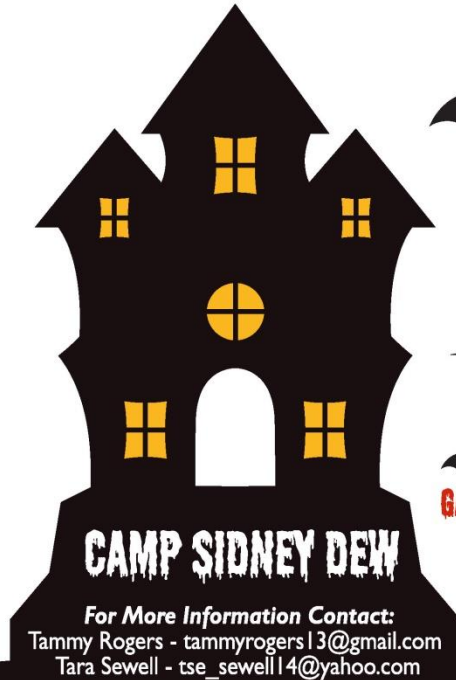
