

Three Rivers Pinewood Derby Championship Race

Saturday, April 1, 2023

The District Pinewood Derby Championship is open to all Cub Scouts who are registered with the NWGA BSA Council. This year there is an open invitation to all scouts, with no Pack qualification requirements.

There will be seven divisions for both Race and Show: Lions, Tigers, Wolves, Bears, Webelos, Arrow of Light, and Family. The Family division is open to members of the Scout's immediate family including all parents and siblings. A Grand Champion race will be run as the last event with the top 3 cars in each Scout division qualifying for the Grand Champion Finals. Attached are the Three Rivers District PWD rules.

Early registration is \$8.00/car. The standard entry fee will be \$10 per car entry into Race and Show for your division. Trophies will be given for placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in all divisions, both Race and Show. Cars will automatically be entered in both categories, Race and Show. Each participant is allowed only one entry.

The standard registration fee can be paid at the event as each car is checked in. Early entry registrations must be submitted and paid by March 24, 2023. **Registration is online at nwgabsa.org, through the link on the main page, or on the Scouting Calendar.**

Race Category: Each division will race a round robin style format with each Scout racing twice on each of the 4 lanes. Electronic timers will be used. The fastest 7 of the 8 runs will be totaled to score the competition.

Show Category: The cars will be judged using a PWD Show Judging Rubric using the criteria of creativity/originality 20pts, workmanship/craftsmanship 20pts, appearance/finish 20pts, and scout influence/effort 40pts. An independent third party will judge, who will have no prior knowledge of the cars or the Scouts.

Check in will begin at 9AM for Lions. Plan to check in at least 45 minutes before your rank's race time.

The order of events will be Lions 10am, Tigers 11am, Wolves 12PM, Bears 1PM, Webelos 2pm, Arrow of Light 3PM, then Family, and finally the Grand Championship.
